To promote the **social and labor inclusion** of all groups at social risk through a comprehensive and multidisciplinary intervention.

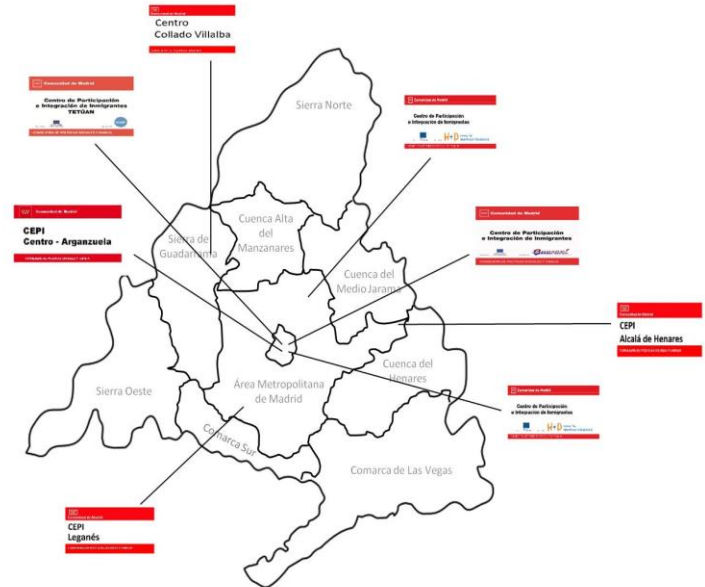
To contribute to the development of **new methodologies** and approaches on the social intervention with vulnerable groups.

Management of the CEPI de Chamartín for 12 years:

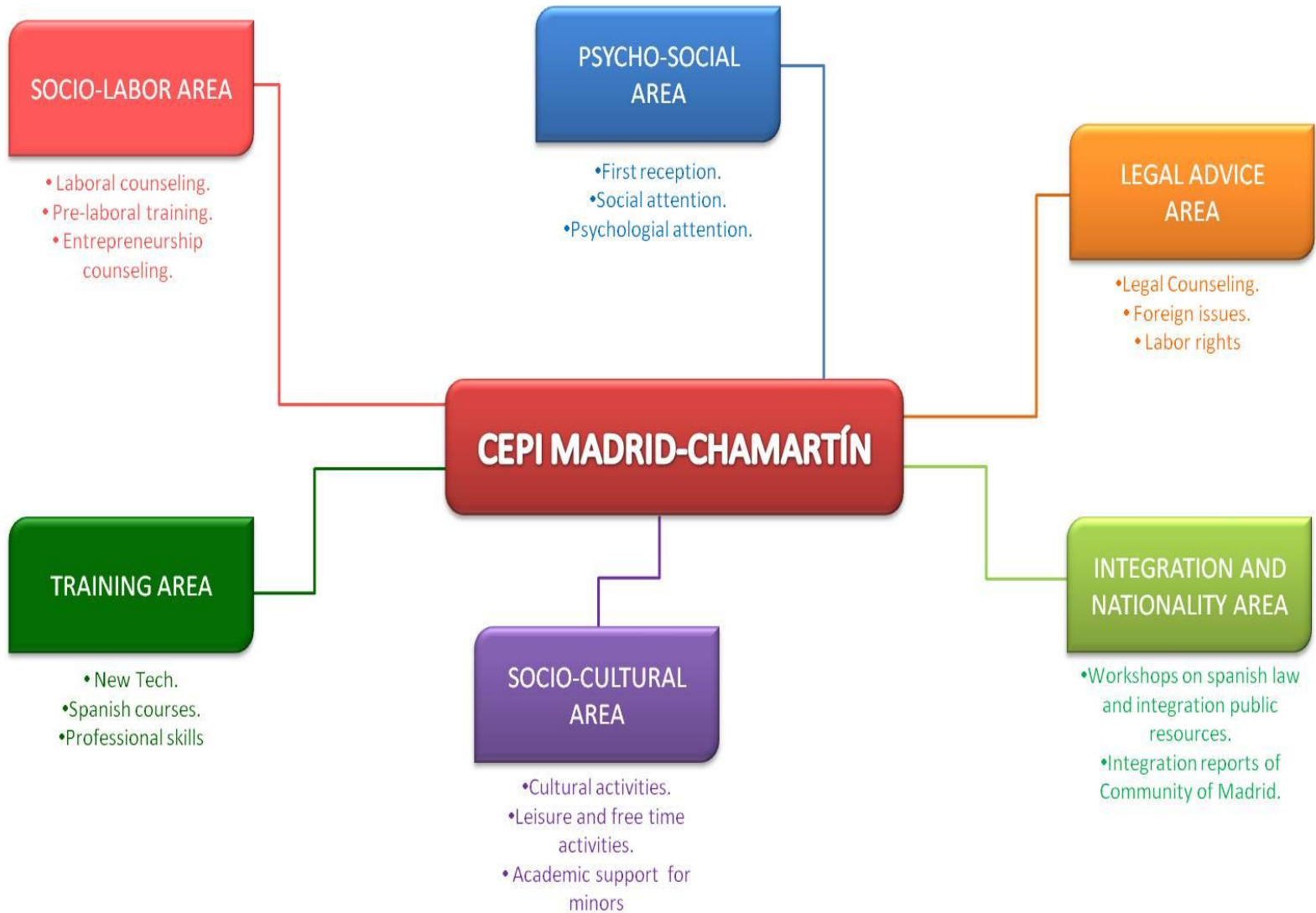
8 official Centers of the Community of Madrid managed by private entities. They are public resources aimed to promote the integration of migrants through individual and group activities.

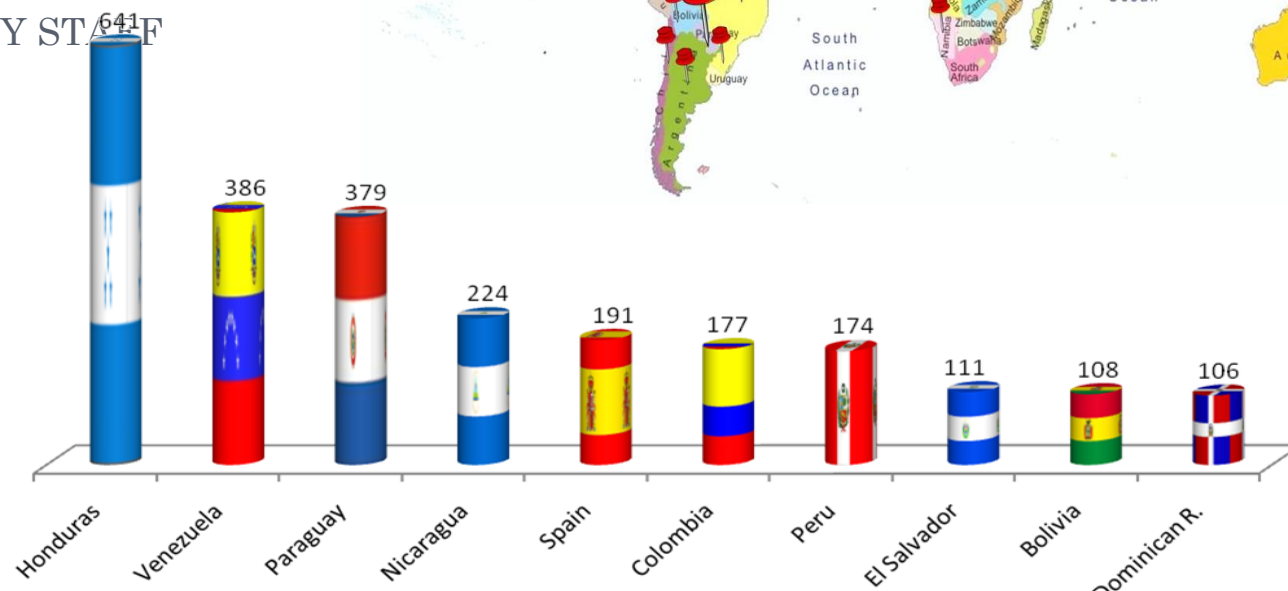
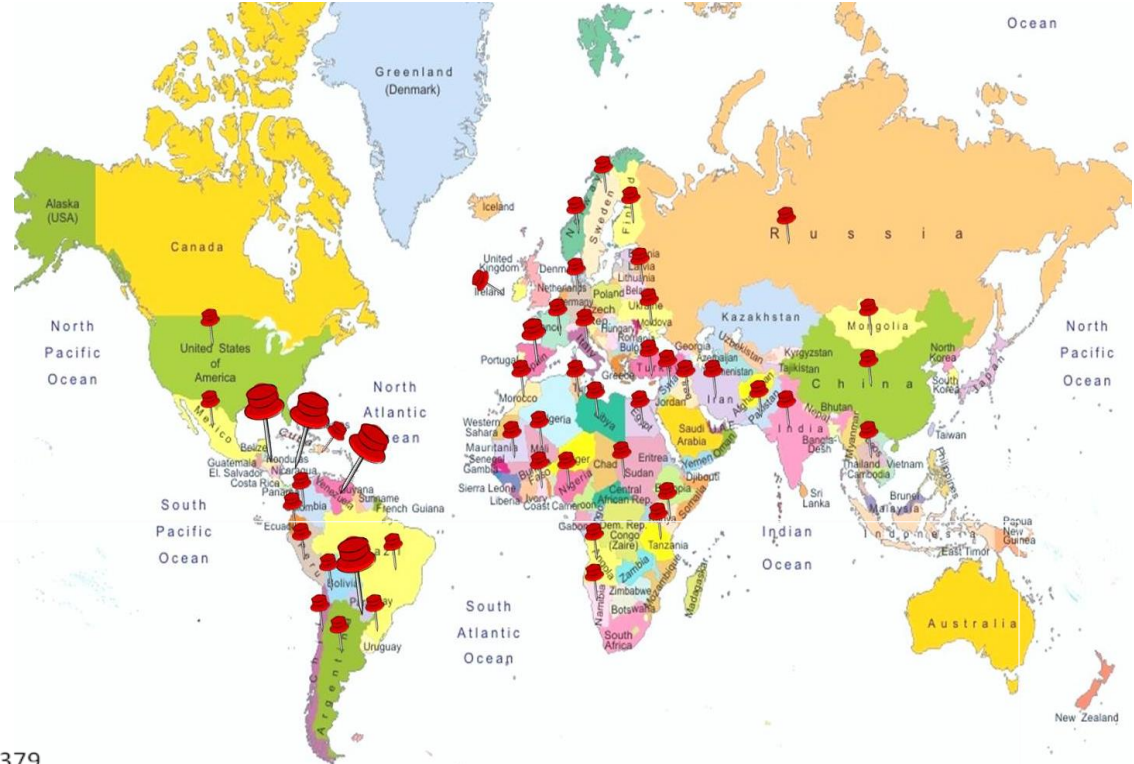
